SOUSS-COMITE SUR LA POLITIQUE ECONOMIQUE SOVIETIQUEACTIVITES ECONOMIQUES DES PAYS COMMUNISTES DANS LES PAYS EN
VOIE DE DEVELOPPEMENT DU MONDE LIBRE HORS
D'EUROPEDONNEES PAR PAYS EN VOIE DE DEVELOPPEMENTNote du Président

Dans le présent document figurent des données statistiques détaillées sur les activités des pays communistes (1) en matière d'aide économique, d'assistance technique et d'échanges commerciaux dans les pays en voie de développement du monde libre hors d'Europe jusqu'à la fin de 1968. Les tableaux ci-joints, par pays bénéficiaire et pays donateur, constituent la base du 12ème rapport du Sous-comité qui couvre la période janvier 1967 - décembre 1968. Le présent document de travail deviendra l'annexe statistique de la version définitive de ce rapport.

A. Aide économique accordée

2. Les chiffres présentés en annexe pour la période 1954-1968 se fondent principalement sur des données fournies par les Délégations des Etats-Unis et du Royaume-Uni. Certaines différences apparaissent entre les chiffres émanant de ces deux sources. Il convient de noter tout d'abord que les Etats-Unis tiennent compte de dons de faible montant, que les experts du Royaume-Uni ne font pas entrer dans l'aide économique. Ces différences, qui sont négligeables ne modifient en rien l'ensemble de la situation. On s'est efforcé, dans les états ci-joints, d'harmoniser les chiffres soumis par les deux pays.

3. Ces différences peuvent également s'expliquer par le fait que l'octroi de certains crédits a peut-être été signalé à des dates différentes par des sources différentes. Dans toute la mesure du possible, c'est la date de signature de l'accord qui a été retenue, plutôt que celle à laquelle l'octroi du crédit a été rendu public. Quoi qu'il en soit, les totaux couvrant l'ensemble de la période 1954-1968 devraient évidemment être les mêmes.

(1) Selon la définition adoptée pour ces rapports par "pays communistes" on entend : l'Union soviétique, la Bulgarie, la Hongrie, la Pologne, la Roumanie, la zone d'occupation soviétique d'Allemagne, la Chine communiste, la Corée du Nord et le Vietnam du Nord. Cette définition exclut la Yougoslavie dont les activités économiques ne sont pas envisagées ici.

4. Enfin, le calcul en dollars des crédits ou des dons peut aussi être à l'origine de certaines différences dans les estimations. Ces crédits sont octroyés soit dans la monnaie du pays donneur (roubles, couronnes, zlotys, etc.) soit dans celle du pays bénéficiaire. Dans le cas de "dons", il a fallu évaluer la valeur des marchandises. Les estimations utilisées pour le présent document sont celles qui ont été soumises par les Etats-Unis.

B. Aide économique utilisée

5. En dehors de rares indications générales, on ne dispose d'aucun renseignement officiel de source communiste sur l'importance de l'aide utilisée chaque année dans les pays en voie de développement; les chiffres sur les tirages effectués sont donc essentiellement des estimations faites par les experts occidentaux, d'après des renseignements détaillés dont le Secrétariat ne dispose pas. La Direction économique, qui s'est efforcée d'harmoniser les chiffres communiqués par les experts des Etats-Unis et du Royaume-Uni, souhaiterait connaître l'opinion des délégations sur les données indiquées pour la période antérieure à 1967, ainsi que pour 1967 et 1968.

C. Assistance technique

6. Les chiffres figurant dans cette rubrique ont été fournis par les Etats-Unis. Ils englobent le nombre de ressortissants des pays communistes qui ont travaillé sur des questions précises dans les pays en voie de développement du monde non communiste pendant au moins un mois de l'année considérée. Ces chiffres, qui sont arrondis à la demi-dizaine la plus proche, ne tiennent pas compte du personnel communiste, détaché auprès des ambassades, consulats ou missions commerciales. Le nombre de ressortissants des pays en voie de développement bénéficiant d'une formation universitaire et technique dans les pays communistes est également indiqué dans ces tableaux.

D. Echanges commerciaux

7. Les données utilisées par les Etats-Unis pour le commerce soviétique pendant les cinq années 1963 à 1967, proviennent de statistiques commerciales officielles d'URSS; les chiffres concernant les exportations des pays en voie de développement correspondent aux importations soviétiques, et ceux des importations, aux exportations soviétiques. Quant aux autres pays communistes, ce sont les statistiques commerciales officielles des pays en voie de développement qui ont été utilisées; dans les quelques cas où les chiffres disponibles ne convenaient pas, on s'est fondé sur des estimations faites par les Etats-Unis. Il n'est pas possible de faire un rapprochement entre les chiffres du commerce soviétique et ceux des autres pays communistes publiés par les pays en voie de développement. Les Soviétiques ne tiennent pas compte dans leurs calculs du fret et des assurances; les importations des pays en voie de développement en provenance des pays communistes sont généralement cités C.A.F., tandis que leurs exportations à destination de ces pays le sont F.O.B.
