Tasks and responsibilities:

- To support internal and external users of projects and products under of EUROSUR 2.0 system;
- To contribute to the preparation of training materials and support the training and coaching to users in Member States and at Frontex on the use of implemented capabilities;
- To transfers EUROSUR business, users and technical needs into business requirements specification;
- To lead the implementation and developing review, test and validation of projects under his remit;
- To support the management of EUROSUR 2.0 product roadmap and the migration of data from legacy systems to new solutions;
- Advise on EUROSUR related applications, reference databases and technologies.

- Capable of leading and providing technical solutions and contributions ensuring that specific requirements are integrated in project roadmaps and technical developments in the domain of EUROSUR 2.0
