### 1. Background

On 27 November 2012, the Political and Security Committee (PSC) adopted the EULEX KOSOVO Internships Concept Paper introducing an internship scheme for EULEX KOSOVO.

The EULEX KOSOVO Call for Contributions for interns is launched containing a number of profiles as described in Annex I.

The interns will deploy in Pristina from mid-January 2015 to mid-June 2015.

The current Call for Contributions is open to EULEX KOSOVO contributing third States<sup>1</sup>.

I kindly invite Member States and contributing third States to put forward qualified intern applicants for the profiles listed in Annex I.

Intern applicants may also apply directly in accordance with the procedure mentioned in Annex I.

## 2. Methodology

- a) Member States and contributing third States are requested to examine the personal profile and job description to ensure that:
- proposed interns meet the listed criteria described in the essential requirements and in the specific job descriptions (**Annex I**).
  - each applicant completes the standard job application form in English (**Annex II**). Applications will be considered only when using this form and indicating which profile the candidate is applying for.
- b) Proposed candidates should satisfy in full the criteria set out in the job description.
- c) I would appreciate if contributing States would submit offers for the internships Call at their earliest convenience, **but not later than close of business on 5 December 2014 (17h00 Brussels time)**.
- d) Member States and contributing third States should submit their personnel offers, by e-mail to the following address:

- e) The Civilian Planning and Conduct Capability (CPCC) will be responsible for notifying contributing States of the outcome of the selection process for supported interns. The duration of the deployment should be of 5 months.
