Dear Ambassador,

I would like to inform you about an opening of two vacancies in my team for seconded Political Advisers, based in Yerevan (Armenia) and Baku (Azerbaijan), and kindly ask for your assistance in bringing the announcement to the attention of your national authorities.

A. BACKGROUND

COUNCIL DECISION (CFSP) 2018/907 of 25 June 2018 extending the mandate of the European Union Special Representative for the South Caucasus and the crisis in Georgia until 29/02/2020.

B. AIM

Both posts should be filled on 1 August 2019. The duration of the deployment will follow the mandate of the EUSR, which will run until 29 February 2020, with a view to possible extension.

Staff seconded to the EU Special Representative shall receive a daily allowance. The daily allowance for Azerbaijan is 95,32€ and for Armenia: 99,30€. These amounts may be subject to adjustment every six months. The remuneration of personnel seconded by a Member State or an EU institution to the EUSR shall be covered by the Member State or the EU institution respectively.

C. METHODOLOGY

Member States and EU institutions are invited to provide secondment offers as follows (only personnel nominations received through official channels from Member States and institutions of the European Union will be considered).

The personal profiles of the proposed candidates should meet the listed criteria described in the attached relevant Terms of Reference.

The closing date for receipt of offers of secondments is Friday 17 May 2019, COB.

The interviews will take place as soon as possible following the closing date.

Member States and EU institutions should submit their secondment offers/applications by email, including a detailed curriculum vitae based on the attached form, to the following addresses:
