ACTION SHEET

I. MBFR: LINK BETWEEN FIRST AND SECOND PHASES

The COMMITTEE:

- (1) successively reviewed ISD/73(2nd revise) - a synthesis of ISD/73(Revised) and the United States paper circulated at the Council meeting of 3rd May - and a further revised draft ISD/73(3rd revise);
- (2) invited the International Secretariat to redraft ISD/73(3rd revise) taking into account the comments made in discussion;
- (3) agreed that the Ad Hoc Drafting Group meet at 9.30 a.m. on Thursday, 9th May, in order to prepare a draft cover note for the report on the basis of page 8 of ISD/73(Revised);
- (4) agreed to continue discussion on the morning of Friday, 10th May, and, if necessary, the afternoon of Monday, 13th May, with the objective of presenting its report to the Council on Tuesday, 14th May.

II. VERIFICATION AND INSPECTION IN MBFR

The COMMITTEE:

- (1) received from the German Delegation suggested new language for inclusion in its draft report ISD/61(4th revise);

- (2) invited the International Secretariat to prepare a further revised draft incorporating the suggested German amendments into ISD/61(4th revise);
- (3) agreed to consider this new draft at its meeting on Friday, 10th May.

III. POLISH VIEWS ON MBFR

The COMMITTEE:

noted a contribution by the Netherlands Representative reporting Polish views on MBFR as expressed by, amongst others, Mr. Strulak in the course of a visit by members of the Dutch Radical Party to Poland on 25th April, 1974.

IV. REPORT ON WARSAW PACT EXERCISES IN BULGARIA

The COMMITTEE:

noted that the Greek Authorities would welcome additional information from other national authorities or the NATO Military Authorities on the recent reports that two Soviet divisions would participate in a Warsaw Pact exercise in Bulgaria (CIG(74)60, Section 4.A refers).

V. NEXT MEETING OF APAG

The COMMITTEE:

agreed that the dates of APAG meeting at Sesimbra in Portugal would be 5th to 7th June.
