CANADIAN TRADE WITH THE USSR AND BULGARIA

Note by the Canadian Delegation

A copy of each of the following documents has been deposited at the Registry of the Division of Economics and Finance for consultation by members of the Committee of Economic Advisers:

a protocol signed at Ottawa on 16th September, 1963 renewing the Trade Agreement between Canada and the USSR of 29th February, 1956 which had previously been extended for a period of three years to 17th April, 1963 by the protocol of 18th April, 1960; this Trade Agreement is now further extended for another three years up to 17th April, 1966;

an exchange of letters dated 16th September, 1963 between the Canadian Minister of Trade and Commerce and the Soviet First Deputy Minister of Foreign Trade, laying down the terms of an understanding for the supply and purchase of Canadian wheat during the three-year period ending 17th April, 1966;

a Trade Agreement with the Peoples' Republic of Bulgaria signed at Ottawa on 8th October, 1963 and valid for a three-year period from the date of signature;

an exchange of letters dated 8th October, 1963 between the Canadian Minister of Foreign Trade and Commerce and the Bulgarian Minister of Foreign Trade laying down the terms of an understanding for the supply and purchase of Canadian wheat during the three-year period of the above-mentioned Trade Agreement.
