ECONOMIC ACTIVITIES OF COMMUNIST COUNTRIES IN THE LESS  
DEVELOPED AREAS OF THE NON-COMMUNIST WORLD OUTSIDE EUROPE

DATA BY INDIVIDUAL LESS DEVELOPED COUNTRIES

Note by the Chairman

The present paper contains detailed statistical information on the activities of Communist countries(1) in the field of economic aid, technical assistance and trade, in the less developed areas of the non-Communist World outside Europe, up to the end of 1968. The attached tables, by individual recipient and donor country, constitute the basic material for the 12th Report of the Sub-Committee on this subject, covering the period January 1967 to December 1968. The present working paper will ultimately become the statistical annex to the final version of this report.

A. Economic Aid Extended

2. The figures attached covering the period 1954-1968 are based mainly on information provided by the United States and United Kingdom Delegations. There is some discrepancy between the figures provided by the two sources. In the first place the United States figures include minor gifts which are not considered by the United Kingdom experts as economic aid. These differences are minor and do not alter the overall picture. In the attached notes an attempt has been made to reconcile the figures from these two sources.

3. Another explanation of the discrepancy may be the fact that some credit may possibly be reported at different dates by different sources. As far as possible, the date of the signature of the agreement has been used rather than the moment at which the acceptance of the credit was publicly announced. However, the totals covering the entire period 1954-1968 should be the same.

(1) According to the agreed definition for these reports, the term "Communist countries" covers: The Soviet Union, Bulgaria, Hungary, Poland, Rumania, the Soviet-occupied Zone of Germany, Communist China, North Korea and North Vietnam. Economic activities of Yugoslavia are not included under this definition.

4. Finally, calculating the credit or grant in dollars may also account for difference in estimates. These credits are extended either in the currency of the donor country (rubles, crowns, zlotys, etc.,) or in the currency of the recipient country. In the case of "gifts", the value of the goods had to be estimated. Estimates used are of US origin.

B. Economic Aid Drawn

5. Since, apart from occasional global indications, there is no official information from Communist sources on the amount of aid utilized annually in the developing areas, figures on drawings are mainly estimates made by Western experts based on detailed information not available to the Secretariat. The Economic Directorate has attempted to reconcile the figures proposed by the US and UK specialists and would welcome the views of the delegations on the figures indicated for the period prior to 1967 and for the years 1967 and 1968.

C. Technical Assistance

6. The figures given under this item are of US origin. They include the number of individuals from Communist countries working on specific projects in the less developed countries of the non-Communist World for a period of at least one month during the year considered. These figures are rounded to the nearest 5. They do not include Communist personnel attached to embassies or consulates or trade missions. The number of academic students and technical trainees from less developed countries being trained in Communist countries is also indicated.

D. Trade

7. Soviet trade data for the five years 1963-67 used by the US sources are derived from official Soviet trade publications; the export figures of the developing countries correspond to Soviet imports, their import figures to Soviet exports. In respect of the other Communist countries, the official trade statistics of the developing countries are used; in a few cases where the figures available were inadequate, US estimates have been used. The Soviet trade figures are not exactly comparable with those of the other Communist countries as reported by the developing countries. Soviet figures exclude freight and insurance; imports of developing countries from Communist countries are generally quoted c.i.f., whereas their exports to the Communist countries are f.o.b.
